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Introduction to the Guideline


The aim of this guideline is to contribute to more significant learning experiences and increasing educational possibilities by using specific tools in the suggested entrepreneurial course. Tools described in this guideline have been carefully selected according to specific tasks and assignments in the course, with various types of game techniques and tools such leaderboards and competition, questionnaires, cooperation, feedback or creativity tools. Incorporating such online tools and cards to the tasks leads to higher degree of interactions and involvement of participants and fosters positive and collaborative relationships in the class. Students will improve their attention, concentration and motivation as well as gain skills and greater degree of autonomy in fulfilling their tasks.

This guideline contains the description of selected tools for gamification in the entrepreneurial course. Each description presents the tool and its features and provides a short description of how to use the tool. Finally, many tools provide a sample assignment, where specific assignment from the entrepreneurial course and supporting material such as template, ready to use cards or online ready to modify materials/presentations can be found.

All the materials and information presented in this guideline are prepared for students, teachers and trainers in the gamified course. Students can use this material to learn about tools and how they can be used for fulfilling their tasks, as well as use prepared templates, cards and links for their work. Teachers and trainers can further develop the prepared materials and modify each of the templates for the specifics of their lecture. All the presented tools have a free version that can be used by both students and teachers. In most of the tools the user needs to be registered in order to create, modify or use templates and features.

The guideline presents and describes tools used in a prepared gamified entrepreneurial course and additional tools supporting the educational process such videos, podcasts, storage and file sharing or scheduling tools.





How to use Canvanizer

Open Canvanizer.com and create an account by clicking on the GET STARTED button in the top right corner. You can sign in with Google, Facebook, Apple, Slack or Microsoft or by using your own email address. You can try out Canvanizer without signing in, however if you want to save your work, you need to have an account. It is easy to use and works on a drag and drop function.

Once you get to the main panel, on the upper left side can see Personal Workspace, by shifting the mouse on Personal Workspace you can open or create a new canvas with appeared buttons. Canvanizer offers you several canvases to work on. If you choose for example Business Model Canvas, you click on the button and click Create canvas (Canvaniter Classic). Canvanizer opens the canvas and shows you instructions how to edit your canvas. By clicking insert you may add your ideas on a sticky note, change the heading and colour. You can easily drag and drop your sticker note to other parts of the canvas. On the bottom you have a brainstorming space, where you can add other sticky notes. You can share your canvas by clicking on "Share canvas" in the upper right corner. You can share it by email or by link to just preview or edit. You can present your business model canvas as a slideshow.

With the free version it is possible to import canvas notes via CVS file, export canvas to Text format for printing, export to CVS to import to other applications or convert.





Name of the tool: Proto.io Official

General information: Proto.io is an industry-leading prototyping platform. It gives designers, entrepreneurs, developers, and anyone with a great idea the power to create fully-interactive web and mobile prototypes of any fidelity that look and work exactly like a real app – all without a single line of code.

Proto.io helps you build, share, present, and test interactive prototypes for any screen size: mobile, tablet, web, TV, or smartwatch. From low fidelity to wireframes and realistic fully animated prototypes.

Technical requirements

No need to download any software. Log in through a browser window is required to access the work. Proto.io Dashboard and Editor are fully compatible with most browsers, including Chrome, Safari, and Firefox. Internet Explorer and Edge are not supported.

Access cost

Proto.io has 4 categories of offerings – Freelancer, Startup, Agency, and Corporate. These are paid versions with the possibility of 50% discounts for students.

A free trial is available and allows you to create prototypes freely. You will be able to convert your account to a Free limited featured plan as soon as your trial expires, which is, however, sufficient for students' projects

How to use Proto.io

When you start your free 15-day full-featured Proto.io trial and sign in to your account, you will see 2 projects preloaded on your Dashboard.

Tutorial project: This is a low-fidelity prototype of a travel app that will guide you to become familiar with Proto.io. Move through the screens and follow the instructions in the yellow bubbles to learn the basics of prototyping in Proto.io. The prototype is incomplete, and you are given instructions on how to complete it.

Smoothies to Door is a completed project for you to explore the capabilities of Proto.io. You can preview it and experience how it would look and feel on a mobile device. You can also open it in the Proto.io mobile app. Try editing it and observe the changes. It demonstrates basic to intermediate-level functionality. Any advanced interactions, animations, or additional functionality are omitted on purpose.

How to create your first project?

Once you sign in see the Dashboard.

- ✓ Click +NEWPROJECT button
- ✓ Select project name
- ✓ Select project type (smartphone, tablet, web desktop, or custom for which you specify the dimensions)
- ✓ Select screen size (comes with device skin). This option doesn't apply to custom devices
- ✓ Click CREATE

Building your screens. You enter the Editor.

- Start populating your screen by dragging in UI components or templates available in the Libraries tab on the right. Customize them by resizing and repositioning on the canvas and editing properties in the Inspector.
- You can also upload your own assets in the bottom right pane and drag them into the canvas.
- Create more screens and repeat the above process.

Adding interactivity

You can create interactions to take you from one screen to another using the interaction wizard. Just pick up the lightning bolt on the left of a selected element and drop it on the destination screen. A relevant interaction is created in the Inspector (seen on the right).

Name of the tool: Figma

General information: Figma is a free, online user interface tool to create, collaborate, prototype, and handoff. It is a design tool to create prototypes of websites and apps for different operating systems.

Figma shares projects, files, pages, and frames with anyone that has permission. This form of selective sharing, from file down to the frame, lets designers, product owners, and developers share exactly what is needed in bug tracking tools and community software like Confluence or SharePoint. As a motion designer, Figma is a great way to quickly design, build, and export files for animation and prototyping. It's easy to use and has all the tools needed to get the job done.

Technical requirements

Figma is predominantly browser-based software, which means it can be run on all full desktop operating systems (MacOS, Windows, Linux, etc), as well as Chrome OS. Figma also has desktop applications available for both MacOS and Windows.

The minimum browser requirements are Chrome 66+, Firefox 78+, Safari 13+, and Microsoft Edge 79+.

Accesscost

Figma has 4 categories of offerings – Starter, Professional, Organization, and Enterprise. The starter version is free and allows you to create prototypes freely, it includes 3 Figma and 3 FigJam files, unlimited personal files, unlimited collaborators, plugins, widgets, and templates as well as a mobile app.

How to use Figma

Figma is a vector design tool that runs in the browser. Use Figma to brainstorm ideas, iterate on designs, create prototypes, and get feedback at any stage of the creative process.

Sign up for a free Figma account at figma.com. With a Figma account, you can create teams - shared spaces, where you can collaborate on files and organize them into projects.

Choose from a free Starter team or a paid Professional team. If you are a student or educator, you can get access to all of Figma's Professional features for free.

Once you've created your team, you can invite members to collaborate. This will give them access to all the projects and files in your team. You can choose what level of access each member has.


Wireframes are simplified designs that are devoid of any style, like color, type, or imagery. They allow us to map out user flows and explore different ways we can structure our app, without having to design any elements, or add any content.

The canvas is the backdrop for all of your designs - it's where you'll add all the frames, shapes, text, and images.

With the great expanse that is the canvas, you need something to put your designs in. Enter frames. Frames are the containers you place your shape, text, and image layers in. You can think of each frame in the canvas as a single screen of your design.

Now you're ready to add some layers to your frame! As this is a wireframe, you can use shapes, like rectangles and ellipses, to represent more complex aspects of the design.

Further, you can create avatars, layer properties, add text, duplicate layers, add different components, and much more.

Miro can be used on different types of devices. You can open Miro in a browser, download the Desktop, Tablet, Mobile app, or use Miro on an interactive display.




Fully supported browsers are Chrome version 70 or higher, Firefox version 70 or higher, Safari version 12 or higher, Opera version 70 or higher, Edge version 44 or higher, and Yandex Browser version 19.10 or higher.

Free version of Miro includes unlimited number of team members, three editable boards, premade templates, core integrations and basic attention management.

General information: Google docs is an on-line document generator that permits to create cooperatively text documents, spreadsheets, presentations and forms.

Technical requirements


Access through website and mobile application. Supported devices Windows, Mac, Android, iOS

Access cost

The free version gives you access to templates for documents, spreadsheets, presentations and, at the same time, it will work as a storage platform to keep your documents, to recover them on-line at any place or to share documents with colleagues and clients.

Google Docs also allows to create:

- questionnaires and on-line forms for students, families or clients. You can download in Excel files the results and create directly the plots and tables with data emerged: Personal data and contact, meeting management, assistance and registration to events, product orders, event comments, perceptions of students, permission, client comments, self- evaluation test, lesson valuation, exams, spreadsheets and course assessment.

How to use Google Docs

First, you have to be registered on google (it could be easier if you already have a Gmail account). Next open <https://docs.google.com/> and go in with your google account. Once you get to the main panel, on the left side you can find four options to create documents: text documents, spreadsheets, presentations and forms. In the central panel you can find your “recent documents”, the documents you already created and the documents shared with you.

Each kind of document has a big number of templates to elaborate your own material (click on “gallery”).



General information: Prezi is a presentation software that uses motions, zoom and spatial relations to create an engaging presentation. This software is used for storytelling and can be used to present any kind of information. Prezi has many templates that are easy to work with. It allows the audience to engage by using many graphic elements and motion at the same time. Prezi has drag and drop functionality which helps presenters to create the presentation easily.

Technical requirements

Access through web page and application. Supported devices: Windows, Mac, Android, iOS

Access cost

Prezi has 4 categories of offerings – Basic, Individual, Students & Educators, Business.

Basic version is free and allows you to create Prezi videos up to 15 minutes and use data import, object animation and templates for your presentation. Other options are paid with a possibility of free trial. Prices vary depending on the selected package and range.

Prezi could help with multiple teaching activities: educate by interactive approach, student presentations and pitches, present in and fun, engaging way, create projects such infographics, reports, posters, create online video lectures.

How to use Prezi

Open Prezi.com and create an account by clicking on the GET STARTED button in the top right corner. You can sign in with Google, Facebook, Apple, Slack or Microsoft or by using your own email address.

Once you get to the main panel, on the left side you can find your presentations in "All projects". You can create a new presentation by clicking on the QUICK START button. You can start from scratch or choose from one on the templates. Prezi offers you to create a videotaped lesson, charts, infographics, presentation, dashboards, reports or posters and other.

When you choose your template, type in the name of your presentation or project. In the free version, your project will be visible on the whole web. Prezi prepared for you many tutorial videos that show you how to work with the tools. If you have selected a presentation, you can see on the left- hand side your slides and their order. You can simply switch the sides using drag and drop. In the central panel you can work on each section by double clicking on the section. In the upper panel you have options "Style" where you can select background, topic, colours, or text style. Further, by clicking on "Insert" you can insert text, image, sticker, gif, audio, video, chart, shape, arrows etc. Last button "Share" allows you to present, view the link of the presentation, add collaborators or add Prezi video with you in the background of the presentation.

When editing slides, you can edit the zoomed area as well, clicking on the arrow next to the green button on the upper left corner. When you are done with your presentation, you can simply present by clicking "Share" and "Present". If you are using the free version, you can only present by being logged into your account and presenting from the web page. Only the paid version offers the possibility to present offline.

Technical requirements



With Canva, students are able to present the solution to assigned tasks in an interesting and engaging way thanks to the large selection of different project design templates (such as Presentation, Infographics, Posters, Lists, etc.).

What is more each task assigned by the lecturers can be developed individually or with other team members (Canva allows real-time collaboration).

Canva allows not only to develop but also share the graphic design with others (depending on privacy setting graphic design can be viewed, edited, or commented on by person/people chosen by students) or to download graphic design (in the different types of the files).

Similar to other online tools, Canva is available 24/7 so both students and lecturers can work whatever they like.

How to use Canva

Open <https://www.canva.com> and create an account by clicking on the SIGN UP button in the top right corner. You can sign in with Google, Facebook or by using your own email address. When you are logged in, you will see your dashboard with all the designs you can make, including presentations, letters, posters, Infographics, and many others. Now you will need to only choose a predefined template (note that at the bottom of each template there is information stating whether this template is free of charge or you need to pay for it). Remember that the buttons on the left are your editing tools. In the predefined template you can add different elements, add a heading, subheading, change the font style and size, add music, images or videos, change background, layout. You can save your graphic design as PNG, JPG, PDF, MP4, PPT file.




- **Storytale for gamification:** when designing a gamified process it's important to create a meaningful general narration to develop all the activities and to increase the motivation of the students. Thanks to the tool this activity is possible (e.g. by using the free template for video presentation). Photo banks



Photo banks help us to make our graphic design projects more attractive and varied, thanks to the availability of images with different themes.

It should also be highlighted that nowadays most of the photos/images published on the Internet are protected by copyright, so it is crucial to know whether a particular image can be used in our graphic design project and under what circumstances.

In this chapter, we have characterised ten image banks. Five of them, which are free, have been described in detail. Another five are mentioned only by name due to the fact that the user has to pay to download images/photos from them.
